Madagascar has been a major partner in the ITEC Programme and over 100 people from Madagascar undertake training courses in India every year.



The Indian Technical and Economic Programme (ITEC) was instituted on 15 September 1964. The programme fully funded by Government of India has evolved and grown over the years. Under ITEC 161 countries in Africa, Asia, East Europe and South America are invited to share the Indian developmental experience acquired over past seven decades. ITEC programmes have generated immense goodwill and substantive cooperation among developing countries.

The Programme has the following components:-

- Training in India of nominees from ITEC partner countries
- Projects such as feasibility studies and consultancy services
- Deputation of Indian experts abroad
- Study Tours
- Gifts of equipments at the request of partner countries
- Aid for disaster relief

Training or capacity building is one of the major activities under ITEC. The professionals and people from developing countries are offered unique training courses, both civilian and defence, at different centres of excellence in India which empower them with not just professional skills but prepare them for an increasingly globalised world.
